COVID-19 statistics received from Alberta Health for the Pincher Creek area:

38 active cases

41 recovered

2 death

81 total

The Pincher Creek area currently has the highest rate of COVID-19 per capita in Alberta's south zone 457.7 per 100 000 people with 38 active cases.

All indoor and outdoor social gatherings are prohibited.

Albertans are legally required to isolate for 10 days if they have any core symptoms that are not related to a pre-existing illness or health condition. If you are feeling unwell, you must isolate and take the [self-assessment online](#) or call health link by dialling 811.

If you experience a loss of income because you're required to isolate or care for someone in isolation, you may be eligible for [financial support](#) through the federal government.
