COVID-19 cases continue rising in the Pincher Creek area, now with 8 confirmed active cases of COVID-19.

The Pincher Creek region is currently classified by AHS as “open”, as we have less than 10 confirmed active cases. If the Pincher Creek region confirms 10 active cases we will move into enhanced public health measures and will remain under the “enhanced” zone restrictions for the period of time the public health order is in effect.

The following mandatory restrictions are in place for the Pincher Creek area:

- No indoor social gatherings in any setting
- Outdoor gatherings max of 10
- Wedding and funeral services max of 10, no receptions permitted
- No festivals or events
- Grades 7-12 at-home learning Nov 30-Jan 11
- ECS-Grade 6 at-home learning after break until Jan 11
- Working from home should be considered, where possible
