COVID-19 cases continue rising across Alberta and the situation is critical. Pincher Creek region is classified by AHS as “open”, while we have less than 10 confirmed active cases. In regards to the enhanced public health measures put into place by the Province, mandatory restrictions are as followed:

- No indoor social gatherings in any setting
- Outdoor gatherings max of 10
- Wedding and funeral services max of 10, no receptions permitted
- No festivals or events
- Grades 7-12 at-home learning Nov 30-Jan 11
- ECS-Grade 6 at-home learning after break until Jan 11
- Working from home should be considered, where possible

Together, these measures will help protect our health care system, keep schools and businesses open as much as possible, and protect vulnerable Albertans.
